

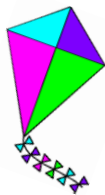
Dear MVCDC Families,

The earned income tax credit (EITC) is a refundable tax credit for low- to moderate-income working individuals and couples, particularly those with children. You qualify if you meet any of the following:

- no children living with you in 2022, and you earned no more than \$16,480 (or a maximum of \$22,610 for married workers)
- lived with one child in 2022, and your family earned no more than \$43,492 (or a maximum of \$49,622 for married workers)
- lived with two children in 2022, and your family earned no more than \$49,399 (or a maximum of \$55,529 for married workers)
- lived with three or more children in 2022, and your family earned no more than \$53,057 (or a max of \$59,187 for married workers)
